Listed below are the options available for families to explore regarding tuition assistance. Most programs have deadlines and require supporting materials from families to process an application.

FOUNDATIONS IN EDUCATION BISHOP'S SCHOLARSHIP FUND <https://wwwFOUNDATIONSINEDUCATION.org/bishops-scholarship-fund/>

The Bishop's Scholarship Fund's mission is to help families afford a Catholic education. Families with children in grades K-8 are eligible to apply. An online application must be completed with FACTS at www.FACTSmgt.com/aid. Supporting documentation is required including your 2018 or 2019 tax return(s) and W-2(s).

Applications will be accepted for *currently registered* families through March 15, 2020. Applications will be accepted through *April 15, 2020 for newly enrolled families*. It should be noted that funds are limited and will be awarded based on need and date of completed application. Deadlines are final.

Please note: applications will **not be considered** by the Bishop's Scholarship Fund until a family has provided all supporting documentation and also completed the St. James School application process, including payment of any required fees. The school will have to verify that enrollment is complete before your financial aid application is processed by FACTS.
